Junior Leadership Day will be held on Friday, April 23 from 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM at St. Patrick's Cathedral in Fort Worth.

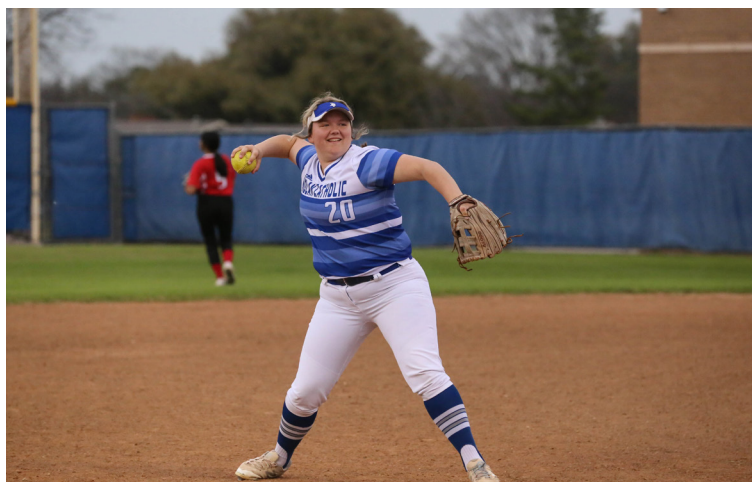
SENIOR COMMUNITY DAY
