Stephen greatly valued his education at both St. Andrew and Nolan Catholic. Before he died, Stephen's wish was to help less fortunate children have the same opportunity he had. One in eight children in Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Fort Worth currently receive financial aid, and many more are in need, if only the resources were available.

Since inception, Stephen's Foundation has provided over \$1.2 million in financial aid to more than 2000 children from 1000 different families. These children attend 19 different Catholic schools in the Diocese of Fort Worth. Additionally, Stephen's Foundation has provided over \$250,000.00 in assistance to children with cancer and their families being treated at Cook Children Hospital.

Annually, the Foundation awards the "Stephen Breen Memorial Foundation Scholarship for a College Freshman," which is a \$5000.00 scholarship credited directly to the recipient's tuition account of their chosen college, university, or seminary. This scholarship is only awarded for the student's freshman year in college.
