**Dear Nolan Catholic Families:** 

We are quickly approaching our re-enrollment period for the 2020-2021 school year, and I would like to share details regarding the registration process, tuition, and grant and aid applications.

Every effort is made to set an affordable tuition rate while balancing the strategic goals and long-term viability of our school. The actual cost to educate a student is twenty-three percent higher than the cost of tuition. We rely on the generosity of families and donors to help us bridge this gap and keep tuition as low as possible. An increase in tuition for the 2020-2021 school year is necessary to keep pace with operation costs while also allowing us to provide the best education for our children with quality educators and programs.

Re-enrollment opens Jan. 21, 2020, and will run through Feb. 21, 2020. You will receive an email with the re-enrollment link on Jan. 20, 2020. It will also be available at www.nolancatholic.org/reenroll. Registrations completed after February 21 will incur a \$480 late re-enrollment fee which will be added to your FACTS account.

In an effort to assist families in meeting this re-enrollment deadline, the Nolan Catholic Business Office will be offering individual appointments on January 27 and February 15 from 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. each date. Staff will be available to assist with the RenWeb and FACTS websites and answer any re-enrollment and grant & aid questions. Please register to attend at www.nolancatholic.org/reenroll. The grant and aid application is available on the Nolan Catholic tuition webpage, which can be found at nolancatholic.org/tuition-and-fees. It is our goal to offer families the necessary support to make a Catholic education a reality.

#### **Grant and Aid Instructions**

The grant and aid application process for the 2020-2021 school year is now open.

#### How to apply for grant and aid?

- Click on the following link to create a <u>new FACTS</u> account: <a href="https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/44SQD">https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/44SQD</a>. If you already have a Nolan Catholic Facts Account, simply log in to that account. If you have a FACTS account from a previous school, you will need to create a new Nolan Catholic FACTS account. On the right-hand side, find a box titled "FACTS Grant and Aid." Click on the blue "Begin Application" link. Follow the prompts to complete the application.
- After completing the application, review your information and click "Submit." You will then be prompted to pay the \$35 application fee.
- The parent/guardian who claims the student as a dependent on the federal tax return is to complete the grant and aid application.
- Parents who are separated/divorced and share the financial responsibility for their student must each complete a Grant & Aid application if both parents are seeking assistance.
- The New Student Grant & Aid application can be submitted without the 2019 federal tax return by submitting your 2018 W-2 and federal tax return. Your application will not be complete until you have uploaded the tax return, W-2, and supporting schedules.
- A complete 2019 federal tax return, and any FACTS-requested supporting documents, must be uploaded for your application to be complete and for your 2020-21 tuition assistance to be applied to your tuition balance.
