Our hope is to continue embracing the Viking spirit generated on our virtual campus! We are working to keep all previously scheduled items on the calendar as we continue to move forward virtually.



Students are Tapped for National Honor Society Friday, March 20



ACT TEST UPDATE

Students registered for the April 4, 2020 ACT test should have received an email notification stating the date was being rescheduled.

Students registered for the April date have the option to register for either the June 13 or July 18, 2020 test dates at no cost.

To change your registration, log in to your ACT.org account and request a test date change. You will be prompted to pay the registration fee. The fee will be refunded within 3-5 business days.

To change to the June, please log into your account no later than May 8. If changing to July, please log in to make the change no later than June 19. If neither dates work for your schedule, click <u>here</u> to contact an ACT customer care representative by June 19.
